Living wage measure moves forward in Santa Clara (Correction)

The Santa Clara County Board of Supervisors today pushed forward a Living Wage Ordinance by a vote of three to one with one abstention. The final vote will come Dec. 16.

The proposal would assure that all companies that contract with the County of Santa Clara pay their employees a living wage of \$19.06 an hour when it takes effect next June.

Supervisor [David Cortese](#), who joined Supervisor [Ken Yeager](#) as the main proponents of the policy, said this was "an important, progressive step for the community," a position supported by the majority of the people at the meeting who testified.
